## TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. Information on the prize and how to enter form part of these conditions of entry. Authorised under NSW Permit No. LTPS/11/07425; ACT Permit No. ACT TP 11/03279; VIC Permit No. 11/1766; SA Permit No. T11/1810.

2. The Promoter is Australian Postal Corporation (ABN 28 864 970 579) trading as "Australia Post" 111 Bourke St, Melbourne, VIC 3000.

3. The promotion commences on 1 October 2011 at 9am (AEST) and ends on 25 November 2011 at 8pm (AEST). Entry is open to customers who spend \$20 or more in a single transaction at a participating Australia Post retail outlet and complete a validated hardcopy entry form by mail. Entries must be received by 8pm (AEST) on 5 December 2011. No responsibility is accepted for late or illegible entries.

Hardcopy entry forms are required to be validated at the point of sale during the promotional period to confirm the purchase greater than \$20 has been made. Validation must be made by an Australia Post representative with an official date stamp at a participating retail outlet at the time of purchase.

Customers can enter as many times as they wish so long as they have a validated entry form for each eligible transaction (to confirm the purchase of \$20 has been made during the promotional period). Only purchases at participating retail outlets are eligible. Online purchases are ineligible.

4. Entry is open to all Australian residents who fulfil the entry requirements. Entrants must be at least 18 years old or must have the permission of their parent(s) or guardian to enter the promotion. If an entrant who is under 18 years of age wins the prize, they will be required to provide proof of a parent or guardian's permission to accept and take a prize.
