## Letters and documents - standard services

There are two delivery timetables available for letters within Australia: Regular and Priority.
For more information regarding delivery timetables, ask at your local Post Office or visit auspost.com.au/ delivery-times.

## Small letters*

Small letters include enveloped mail, lettersheets and unenclosed postcards.
A small letter is:

- no larger than $130 \mathrm{~mm} \times 240 \mathrm{~mm}$
- no thicker than 5 mm
- no heavier than 250 g .

To avoid small letters being trapped in machinery or other letters, small letters should exceed $88 \mathrm{~mm} \times 138 \mathrm{~mm}$. Sealing of envelope mail is preferred. However if posted unsealed, the opening should not exceed 88 mm .

## Large letters*

A large letter is:

- rectangular in shape
- no heavier than 500g
- no thicker than 20 mm
- no larger than $260 \mathrm{~mm} \times 360 \mathrm{~mm}$
- not a small letter

## *Priority timetable

Prices above and on the opposite page are for the Regular timetable. To send as Priority, affix one Priority label next to the postage stamp, concession stamp/s or postage paid image. Priority labels can be purchased at a cost of $\$ 0.70$ each from any Post Office or auspost.com.au/priority-labels.
Available in singles, booklets of five or sheets of twenty.


## Concession Stamps*

Concession Stamps are available to eligible Federal Government concession card holders with a MyPost concession account and can only be used on small and large domestic letters as per the table below. You can buy up to 50 concession stamps per year, in booklets of 5 . For more information ask at your Post Office or visit auspost.com.au/ concession-stamps.
Letters posted with a Concession stamp are delivered to the Regular timetable. For Priority refer to Page 4.

## Conditions for same state prices

Bulk letter articles attract "same state prices" when lodged within the same state as the delivery address (as defined in the Barcode Sort Plan. For charging purposes, the Australian Capital Territory is considered to be part of New South Wales, and South Australia does not include Northern Territory.
Note: For External Territories (Norfolk Island 2899, Christmas Island 6798, Cocos (Keeling) Islands 6799 and Australian Antarctic Territories 7151) the GST free price will be the same as the GST inclusive price shown in the price tables.

## Print Post

Print Post is a service for the delivery of approved periodical publications to addresses within Australia:

- articles measuring $260 \times 360$ (maximum size) $\times 20 \mathrm{~mm}$ (thickness)
- up to 1 kg in weight
- minimum quantity of 100 copies

Refer to the Print Post Service Guide for more information.


* Surcharge of 5 cents per item applies where the minimum barcode threshold, correct addressing or plastic wrapping conditions have not been met. Refer to the Print Post Service Guide for more information.


## Returns of Print Post articles

Each undeliverable article is returned to the nominated return address on the article by ordinary post. The cost of return postage, assessed at the ordinary post price, is payable by the organisation identified in the return address.

- For small articles, the published small letter retail prices apply.
- For large articles up to 500 g , the published large letter prices for a given weight will apply.
- For articles over 500 g , published parcels own packaging 500 g to 1 kg charges will apply.


## PreSort Letter service

The PreSort Letter service offers reduced charges to customers who sort their letters before lodgement and comply with relevant mailing conditions. Refer to the PreSort Letters Service Guide.

- that are endorsed by the Australian Taxation Office (ATO) as an Income Tax Exempt Charity (ITEC) or as a Deductible Gift Recipient (DGR); and
- for sending pre-sorted small and large letter articles for the purpose of fundraising and promotion activity.

## Unaddressed Mail

The Unaddressed Mail service is a cost effective way to help promote your business，generate store traffic or build your database．You can target available private and／or business delivery points in any locality in Australia －including private boxes．A Premium Unaddressed Mail service is also available which has a shorter booking and lodgement time than standard Unaddressed Mail．

－Proof of posting only when an article is presented at a Post Office counter and accompanied by a Registered Post lodgement form（8836964／65）or lodgement receipt
