Entry Restrictions	Open only to Australian residents aged 18 or over who are (or who become) MyPost Concession Card holders except directors, officers, management and employees (and the immediate families of directors, officers, management and employees) of the Promoter or of the agencies or companies associated with this competition.
Overall Competition Period	12:01am (AEST) on 01/07/18 to 11:59pm (AEST) on 30/09/18.
Entry Periods	During the Overall Competition Period, entries will open at 12:01am (AEST) on the first day of a calendar month and close at 11:59pm (AEST) on the last day of that calendar month.
Eligible Transaction	Any transaction made in an Australia Post outlet requiring a monetary purchase.

- 2 **Entries via hard copy entry form:** Where entry is via hard copy entry form, entries must be on the original entry form and must be submitted and received by the Promoter in accordance with the Entry Method section of these conditions of entry.
- 3 **Electronic Entries:** Entries are deemed to be received at the time they are received by the Promoter's database. The Promoter has no control over communications networks and is not liable for any problems associated with them due to traffic congestion, technical malfunction or otherwise. The Promoter is not liable for any consequences of user error including (without limitation) costs incurred. Entrants who enter using multiple email addresses, phone numbers or aliases may be disqualified.
- 4 **Late, lost, incorrect or ineligible entries:** The Promoter is not liable for late, lost, incomplete, misdirected, incorrectly submitted, delayed or illegible entries, correspondence or claims for prizes due to error, omission, tampering, theft, destruction or otherwise.

 - (d) behaves in a manner which may diminish the good name or reputation of the Promoter, any of its related bodies corporate or the agencies or companies associated with this competition; or

- 16 **Limitation of liability:** Without limiting the previous paragraph, the Promoter and its associated agencies and companies will not be liable for any damage, loss or delay in transit to prize/s.
- 17 **Promoter's assignment of rights:** If for any reason any aspect of this competition is not capable of running as planned, including by reason of computer virus, communications network failure, bugs, tampering, unauthorised intervention, fraud, technical failure or any cause beyond the control of the Promoter, the Promoter may in its sole discretion cancel, terminate, modify or suspend the competition, or invalidate any affected entries, subject to the approval of the relevant gaming authorities if required.
