

Election Promo Post

What is Election Promo Post?

Election Promo Post is a discounted service for electoral candidates and political parties to send bulk volumes of addressed promotional mail within Australia up to eight weeks prior to a government election. It offers reduced prices based on mail being barcoded and sorted, enabling more efficient processing.

What qualifies?

Volume: Minimum of 4,000 barcoded articles per lodgement.

Articles must be promotional in nature: The mail piece needs to provide political or campaign information, or member, party or policy information, intended to win favour of constituents. The information can include how to vote information or polling locations when it is incorporated within the letter or pre-populated with candidate selection. E.g. Vote 1 Mary Smith.

Election Promo Post articles must be prepared, sorted and lodged in accordance with the *PreSort Letters service guide*, available online at **auspost.com.au/presort**

Lodgement

If paying with your Australia Post account, articles must be lodged at the lodgement point/s nominated on your account.

For lodgements greater than 100,000 articles for Priority delivery, please advise your Australia Post Account Manager at least three business days prior to ensure a timely delivery.

Small articles only.

Delivery

There are two delivery options:

- **Priority** our faster delivery option, delivered up to 2 days faster than Regular delivery.
- Regular our standard option, delivered within 3–7 business days.

How to send Election Promo Post

→ Apply (new customers only)

To use Election Promo Post you need to complete an application for the PreSort Letters service. This can be done any time prior to an election. The *PreSort Letters application* form is available at all Post Offices or online at

auspost.com.au/presort

You can pay for Election Promo Post by cash, credit card, postage meter or on your Australia Post Account.

Assess your articles

Ensure your articles qualify—they must be promotional in nature. Refer to the previous page and if you are still unsure email a pdf copy of your article to: **BulkMailProducts@auspost.com.au**

Speak with your mail house, Account Manager or the team at your local lodgement facility.

/ Lodgement and payment

Election Promo Post is available to be lodged at all lodgement points across Australia if paying by cash, debit/credit card or postage meter.

If payment is to be made using your Australia Post account, then lodgement must occur at the approved lodgement facilities* nominated on your Australia Post account and the *PreSort Letters* application form.

Complete the *Election Promo Post lodgement document*. Take your completed form, with your articles and two unsealed samples, to the lodgement point, or your mail house may use the Electronic Lodgement Management System (e-LMS).

Please note: For Priority lodgements greater than 100,000 articles please advise your Australia Post Account Manager at least three business days prior to lodgement to ensure timely delivery.

Prepare your mail

A mail house or similar agent can prepare your articles. Refer to the *PreSort Letters service guide* for detailed instructions on how to prepare and sort the articles.
