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Introduction

Your eParcel Contract gives your business access to flexible, scalable shipping solutions.

Connecting your account with our eCommerce partners streamlines order management, automates label generation, and unlocks efficiency benefits like faster fulfilment and fewer errors.

eParcel is designed for higher-volume businesses with advanced features and negotiated rates, while MyPost Business (MPB) is ideal for smaller volumes.

Before you get started

Before you can set up an integration, you'll need two things:

1. A MyPost account

If you don't have a MyPost account, head to the [MyPost page](#) to create a free account.

2. Your Australia Post account number

To locate your account number, check an invoice or in the Parcel Send platform, or ask your Account Manager.

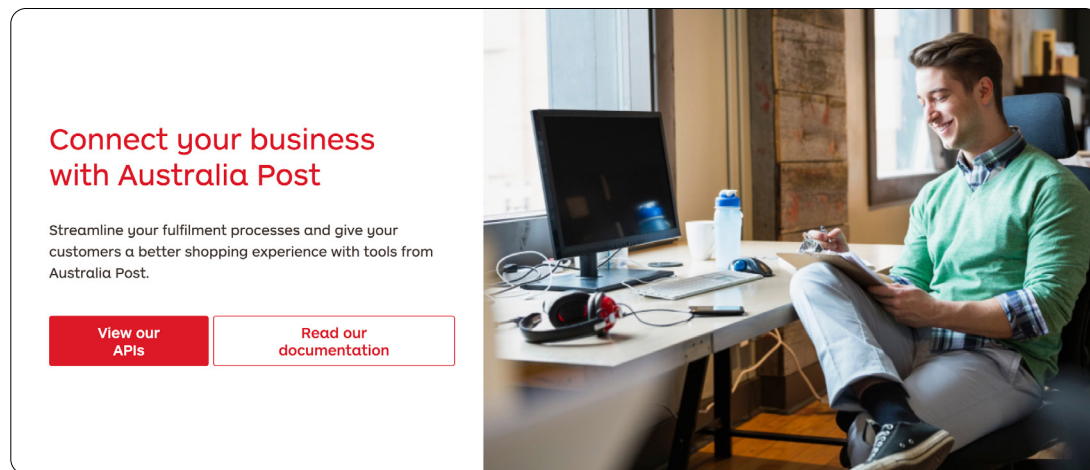

Log in to the developer centre

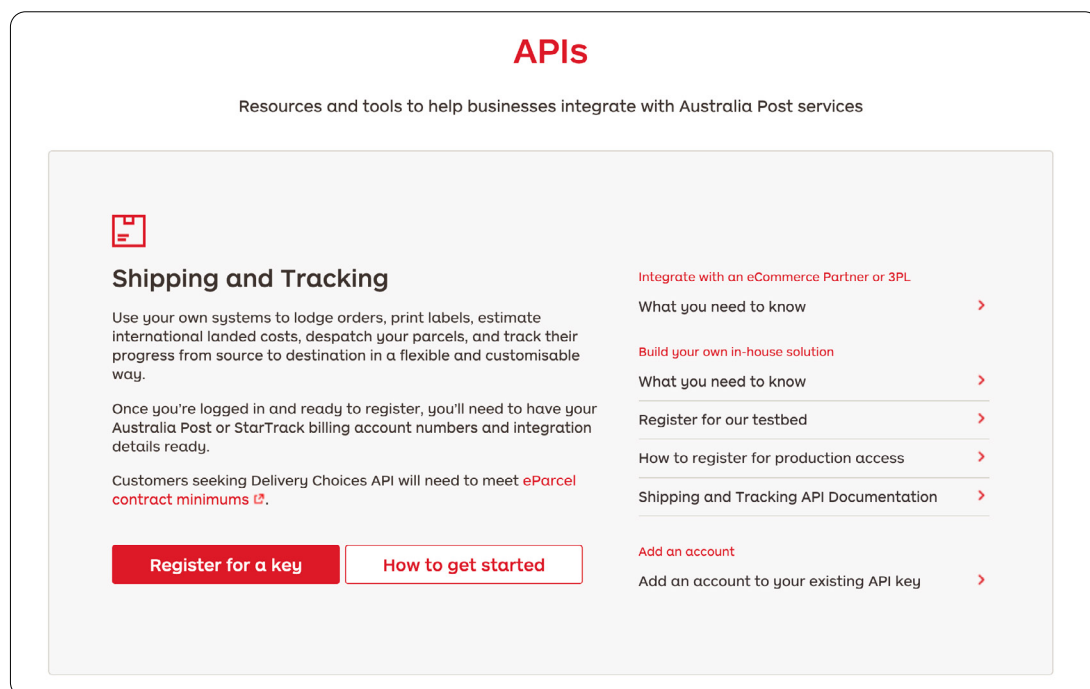
Log in to the [Australia Post Developer Centre](#) using your MyPost account.

Register for an API key

Once you've logged in, select **View our APIs**.



Under the Shipping and Tracking header, select **Register for a key**.



Enter your eParcel Contract account number and select **Complete registration**.

The following form will appear on your screen. Enter your contact and account details and click **Next**.

Shipping and Tracking API Registration

Complete the following fields to get a Shipping and Tracking API Key.

The Shipping and Tracking APIs enable you to lodge shipments and generate labels for printing, get an estimate of the delivery price for available products and track the progress for one or more consignments or articles.
