

'How-to-Vote' Unaddressed Mail

Information for federal election candidates.

'How-to-vote' Unaddressed Mail is a special service for sending information to constituents on how to complete their ballot paper, should a federal election be called within 35 days or less of the polling day. This service provides an extra day to lodge mail and offers early delivery so that mail can be delivered the week that early voting commences.

Our standard Unaddressed Mail service requires lodgement five business days before delivery commences (same state deliveries). 'How-to-vote' cards can only be printed after nominations are declared, which occurs at least 11 days after the issue of writs. If writs are issued for an election to be held within 35 days or less, then the declaration of nominations would happen too late for the standard Unaddressed Mail service to meet the early voting period, which starts 12 days before the election. Therefore, we offer this special service to help get your 'How-to-vote' cards into the hands of your constituents as soon as possible.

Delivery of the cards will be by the end of the first week of early voting commencement with some deliveries occurring in the previous week. In electorates that receive higher volumes of 'how-to-vote' mail it may take a little longer and additional delivery days will be required during Easter due to public holidays.

Only 'how-to-vote' federal election cards can be sent, and they can only be delivered within the same state to where they are lodged.

Bookings under these arrangements cannot be made until the election date is announced and articles must be lodged within 24 hours of the time shown on the Booking Confirmation Advice.

If the election is called with writs issued for an election period of at least 36 days, this special booking arrangement is not available and normal Unaddressed Mail booking conditions will apply.

At a glance



Bookings can only be made once a federal election date has been announced.

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In advance: set up an Australia Post account (if required)

Well before an election campaign, ensure you have an Australia Post account to access the political rates for Unaddressed Mail.

Having an account is essential if you are using a mail house, printer or similar agent to prepare and lodge the articles on your behalf. They cannot access the political rates on their account, so must make a booking using your account. The agent will need to be provided access to your account for this purpose.

To set up an account, contact your Australia Post account manager or call 13 11 18.

You can also pay for your lodgement by cash or EFTPOS however our standard rates will apply and you will not be eligible for the political rates.



Step 1 - Plan and book your Unaddressed Mail campaign

The special 'How to vote' arrangements will be available if an election is called within 35 days or less of the polling day. If this is not the case, you will need to make either a Standard or Premium booking.

You can use our online tool, Campaign Targeter to plan and map your campaign geographically. Follow the steps within Campaign Targeter to email your booking to our Unaddressed Mail team.

You can book your campaign for your federal electorate by completing an Unaddressed Mail Political Booking Request.

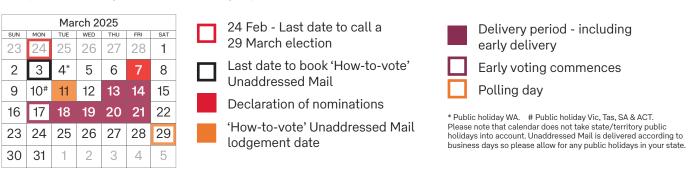






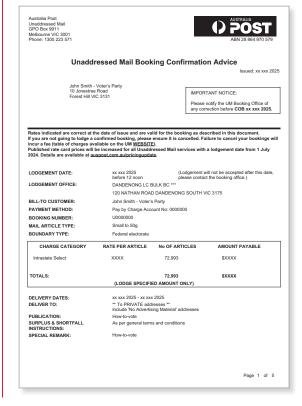
Example of scheduling with 29 March Polling Day

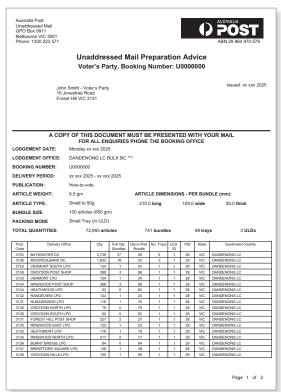

Booking confirmation

- Within three business days you will receive a Booking Confirmation Advice and a Mail Preparation Advice (examples shown below) that will provide details about preparing your mail for lodgement, including how many delivery points which will help you work out your print quantities.
- It is important to check the details of your Booking Confirmation and advise the Unaddressed Mail team of any changes within 24 hours.





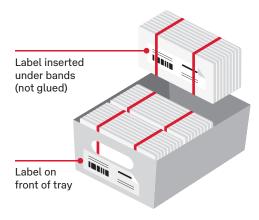


Step 2 - Prepare your mail

Now that you've made your booking and received your Booking Confirmation, it's time to prepare your articles so they are ready for lodgement when the election is called.

- Sort your articles into bundles and trays based on the delivery office as per the mail preparation advice sent with your Booking Confirmation.
- Each bundle quantity must match the quantity shown in the Mail Preparation Advice.
- Secure each bundle with two rubber bands as shown below.
- Ensure labels are firmly fixed on the front of each tray as well as the front of each bundle.

If you need mailing trays or unit loading devices (ULDs) they can be obtained at no cost from your nominated Australia Post lodgement facility.





Step 3 - Lodgement and payment

After the election is called, the prepared articles must be lodged as per the date on the Booking Confirmation Advice.

You will need to provide the following:

- Booking Confirmation Advice
- Mail Preparation Advice
- Mail Lodgement Documents
- A mail sample (unsealed if enveloped)

Payment is required at the time of lodgement and can be made by:

- Charging to your Australia Post account (in order to access the correct political postage rate and you must use this option if an agent is lodging mail on your behalf)
- Cash
- EFTPOS

If you choose to pay by cash or EFTPOS our standard rates will apply and you will not be eligible for the political rates.

Things to keep in mind:

- Bookings can only be made after the election is announced and the election period is 35 days or less.
- All articles must be prepared according to the instructions on the Booking Confirmation Advice and lodged at the Australia Post facility indicated on the advice.
- Make sure to cancel unwanted bookings by the business day before lodgement to avoid a No Show Fee.
- Should the election period be 36 days or more, usual Unaddressed Mail booking and lodgement dates will apply.
- Bookings can be made either online (at umonline.auspost.com.au) or with the Unaddressed Mail team.



Please note: Australia Post will endeavour to deliver articles by the end of the first week of early voting. Delivery of all articles cannot be guaranteed within this timeframe, particularly electorates that receive a high volume of 'How-to-vote' Unaddressed Mail bookings.

The Unaddressed Mail Service is not designed for and does not guarantee delivery within electoral boundaries, therefore, Australia Post does not provide any warranties in respect of delivery points and the accuracy of delivery point counts within electoral boundaries.
